- Establish, implement and monitor effective and appropriate accountability directives, policies and procedures for state agencies and their recipients that are in accordance with the accountability and transparency guidelines and objectives of the [American Recovery and Reinvestment Act](#) as well as OMB's Recovery Act instructions and guidance.

### Our Objectives

- Account, track and report, as required, to OMB on:
  - How Recovery funds received by the state agencies are being distributed/used;
  - The dollar amounts and percentages of awarded Recovery monies actually spent;
  - The operational status and timelines of the Recovery-funded projects;
  - The cumulative number of jobs created and/or saved; and
  - Other details as may be required by OMB.
- Provide the public with the means to easily identify and locate Tennessee recipients of Recovery Act awards and grants and how and where those funds have been spent.
- Ensure that Tennessee state government agency Recovery Act 1512 reports, detailing each agency's Recovery Act expenditures, meet all required federal reporting requirements and those of the [Office of Tennessee Recovery Act Management](#).
